


# Educational system


- Freedom of education
  - Freedom given to pupils and parents to choose the school that suits them
  - Freedom of school management
- Public schools – private schools
  - Public schools run and financed by the public authorities
  - Public grant-aided schools run by provinces or municipalities
  - Private grant-aided schools run by private associations
- Per capita funding
- Quasi-market





# Perspectives

- From the educationalist point of view
  - SNA could be a great tool to analyse school quasi-markets (Belgium, Netherlands, UK, ...)
  - What is the position of a school on the market?
  - Are there clusters of school exchanging pupils among each other?
- From the social network analyst point of view
  - Pupils flows between schools provide great data for the social network analyst
  - What measures of centralization are useful to describe this sort of networks?
  - How to quantify hierarchies in weighted networks (Krackhardt, 1994)
